

## REACH POLICY ON SUBSTANCES OF VERY HIGH CONCERN AND BANNED AND RESTRICTED SUBSTANCES

REACH is a European Directive on chemical substances and requires chemicals used in manufacture and retail to be traceable. The aim of REACH is to improve the protection of human health and the environment from the risks of chemicals.

REACH bans or restricts the use of certain chemicals and substances in the manufacturing process. The REACH Candidate List on Substance of Very High Concern and Annex XVII to Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 set out those chemicals and substances that are either banned or restricted in the manufacturing process.

These lists are evolving and are updated on a regular basis. All suppliers must ensure they keep up to date with the changes.
